**LAW No. 2004/29**

**ON AN AMENDMENT TO LAW No.2003/3 ON THE FORESTS OF KOSOVO**

The Assembly of Kosovo,

Pursuant to the Authority given by Chapters 9.1.26, 9.1.44 and 9.1.45 of Constitutional Framework on Provisional Institutions of Self-Government of Kosovo.

Taking into consideration the necessity to change and amend Law No. 2003/3 on the Forests of Kosovo, for the purpose of having a fully applicable law, and given the changes in the Criminal Code of Kosova,

Approves:

**THE LAW ON AN AMENDMENT TO LAW No.2003/3 ON THE FORESTS OF KOSOVO**

Article 1

In the Law No.2003/3 for the Forests of Kosovo approved from the Assembly of Kosovo in article 36, points 36.1; 36.2; 36.3; 36.4; 36.5; and 36.7 – words “In addition to any other damages that may be due under law, the court may order a person to pay a fine” are deleted and replaced with words: “The court shall fine a person for minor offences with a fine”

Article 2

In article 36.3 point a) is new added as follows: “a) The cutting or damaging of one or more timber in a forest, with the aim of stealing or appropriating it, when the amount of the cut timber does not exceed two cubic meters”

Point a) of this article becomes point b); point b) becomes point c) while point c) becomes point d)

### Article 3

In article 36, point 36.6 words: “In addition to any other damages that may be due under law, the court may order a parent to pay a fine” are deleted and replaced with words: “The court shall fine a parent for minor offences with a fine”.

### Article 4

In article 36 after point 36.7 should be added a new point 36.8 as follows:

“36.8 for violations from article 36 points 36.1/a; 36.2/a and f; 36.3/a, b and c; and 36.4/c – next to a fine for cutting of woods, their transportation, the processing of wooden and non-wooden forestry products, without a permission, previous marking, stamping or without a transportation permission, all things used for carrying out these activities may be confiscated as a preventive measure.

Items from this Section may be temporarily taken from the violator by a Ranger, forest inspector, police or by other authorized persons”.

### Article 5

The present law shall enter into force after adoption by the Assembly on the date of its promulgation by the Special Representative of the Secretary-General.
